COACHING FOR AGENCY Tips for Building Relationships



MUTUAL UNDERSTANDINGS

Define what the coach role is meant to be and what it isn't:

- Create norms that reflect your school's values
- Honoring time for coaching.

FOLLOW THE TEACHER'S LEAD

- Go into classrooms without an agenda or looking to "fix" something.
- Let leachers lead the way for the work to follow.

MAKE TIME TO SHARE

Make time to share personal stories to get to know each other. Share stories about:

- the journey to becoming a teacher
- what is most important about learning.
- the biggest successes or failures.

ASK QUESTIONS AND REAFFIRM

- Paraphrase what teachers say to confirm understanding and show they are heard.
- Ask open ended questions in an effort to understand

OPEN UP TO MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVES

- There is always more than one way to do something.
- When you see things differently, encourage more discourse

CREATE SAFETY

- Establish that the focus is on student learning and not a teacher's ability.
- Encourage progress about professional goals
- Celebrate what is working well because there is always something to celebrate.
